## **GUIDELINES REGARDING PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES USING SERVICES OF SCRIBE**

The facility of Scribe / Reader would be allowed to Visually Impaired (VI), Orthopedically Challenged (OC) and candidates suffering from autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness who have disability of 40 % or more if so desired by the person. The facility of scribe is meant for only those candidates with disabilities who have physical limitation to write including that of speed. In all such cases where a scribe is used, the following rules will apply:

- Please ensure that you are eligible to use the services of scribe as per Govt. of India guidelines governing the recruitment of Persons with Disabilities.
- The candidate will have to arrange his/ her own scribe at his/ her own cost and the scribe can be from any academic discipline.
- Both, candidate as well as scribe will have to give a suitable undertaking, in the prescribed format with
  passport size photograph of the scribe. Further, in case it later transpires that the candidate/scribe has
  suppressed any material facts, the candidature of the applicant will stand cancelled, irrespective of the
  result of the test/ examination.
- Candidates with disability who have physical limitation to write including that of speed shall be allowed compensatory time of 20 minutes per hour of the examination whether availing the facility of scribe or not.
- Any candidate who is not eligible to use scribe as per the guidelines referred to above, but uses scribe in
  the examination shall be disqualified/debarred from certification. Any candidate who is using scribe should
  ensure that he/she is eligible to use scribe in the examination as per the above guidelines. Any candidate
  using scribe in violation of the above guidelines shall stand disqualified and can be expelled from exam
  without notice, if has already attempting / attempted the exam.

In Computer Proficiency test of Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ), scribe can only read the Questions and Options available. If Scribe is found to be involved in any cheating, providing answers or any malicious activity will lead applicant to be disqualified/debarred from the exam. In the test of Typing, scribe can read the content to be typed and can also inform the applicant for the correctness of the typed content, visible on the assessment screen.

including that of speed shall be allowed compensatory time of 20 minutes per hour of the examination whether availing the facility of scribe or not.

- (b) In the test of Computer Proficiency the Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ), scribe can only read the Questions and Options available. If Scribe is found to be involved in any cheating, selecting answers or any malicious activity will lead applicant to be disqualified/debarred from the exam. In the test of typing, scribe can read the content to be typed and can also inform the applicant for the correctness of the typed content, visible on the assessment screen.
- 3. In view of the importance of the time element, the examination being of a competitive nature, the candidate undertakes to fully satisfy the invigilator that there was/is necessity for use of a scribe as he/she has physical limitation to write including that of speed by the disabilities as mentioned in Paragraph 1.
- 4. The disability certificate issued by the competent medical authority is attached herewith.
- 5. We hereby declare that all the above statements made by us are true and correct to the best of our knowledge and belief. We also understand that in case it is detected at any stage of examination that we do not fulfill the eligibility norms and/or that the information furnished by us is incorrect/false or that we have suppressed any material fact(s), the candidature of the applicant will stand cancelled, irrespective of the result of the online test(s). If any of these shortcomings is/are detected even after the candidate's result declaration, his/her score card is liable to be cancelled. In such circumstances, both signatories will be liable to criminal prosecution.
